## Council Meeting July 28, 2025

The Maysville Board of Aldermen met in regular session on Monday, July 28, 2025 at 6:00 pm pursuant to the Missouri Sunshine Law 610.021.

Mayor Ronnie Pearl called the meeting to order with the following members present: Clint Sollars, Darrell Conley, Amy Justus and Larry Zieber.

Also present were City Clerk Pat Fisher-Johnson, TH Bosler, Jennifer Justus and Michele Allwood.

The meeting was called to order and Mayor Pearl led us in the pledge followed by a prayer from Alderman Conley.

Alderman Sollars made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Seconded by Alderman Justus. Motion carried. This included minutes of the July 28, 2025 meeting and the following checks: Water 6954-6980, Wastewater 3540-3546, Street 4478-4482, General 22061-22067, Pk 1239 and Payroll 10985-11009.

Alderman Sollars reported that Tony has been working on ruts on Wilson, Railroad, and Kennedy Drive.

Jennifer reported she has requested MO-Dot clean the storm drains along 33 Highway.

City Clerk reported she has received several complaints regarding the reseeding along Hwy 6 from the curbing project. MO-DOT is going to send someone out to look at it.

Michele has contacted Bartlett & West about feeding ammonia again at the plant. Barlett & West are going to call DNR to discuss doing this again.

Alderman Sollars reported that the rain has been a damper on mowing and some of the projects the city crew has been working on. But have completed some projects since last meeting – new roof on former bathroom by the street shed,

sprayed for duck weed at lagoons, working on tree removal on the dam, and fixing and servicing equipment.

City clerk brought up a water account that has a large outstanding balance for two years. Water customer has been making payments but it has been two years. Board asked that a letter go out to try to get account current very soon.

Alderman Justus made a motion to go into closed session at this time to discuss legal/personnel issues. Seconded by Alderman Sollars. Roll call vote: Conley – yes, Sollars – yes, Justus – yes and Zieber – yes. Motion carried.

Alderman Sollars made a motion to go back into open session. Seconded by Alderman Conley. Roll call vote: Conley – yes, Sollars – yes, Justus – yes, and Sollars – yes. Motion carried.

City Clerk reported that Highway 6 will be closed from Hillcrest to Water Street to replace the tube under the highway for the school from July 28<sup>th</sup> to August 11. Motorists will be asked to use Route 31 to Route 36 to Route 33.

The board reviewed some of the equipment that was used by the police department. The board asked City Clerk to send notice of radar gun for sale out to other city clerks to see if any other police department is interested.

Alderman Sollars made a motion to approve the financial statement for the last 6 months. Seconded by Alderman Conley. Motion carried.

The Board approved Phase two of the connection to the water line. City Clerk will send approval letter to our engineer to send to the state for approval.

Alderman Sollars reported that he has received a bid from EZ Electric to place a breaker box in the new street shed for \$3500. The crew can then run wiring to the breaker box so they can have power for lights and plugging in equipment. Alderman Conley made a motion to approve this bid. Seconded by Alderman Zieber. Motion carried.

Alderman Sollars reported there was an equipment auction in Lathrop on August 11 and there were a couple of items on the sale flyer that might be beneficial for

the city to purchase. Board stated if the equipment goes reasonable, permission to then purchase.

The City will be putting our dump truck up for bid.

Approved Asphalt should be in town in late August to do some street work again this year.

With no further business, Alderman Zieber made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Alderman Conley. Motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 pm and the next meeting will be August 11 at 6:00 pm.
