

Council Meeting
April 13, 2026

The Maysville Board of Aldermen met in regular session on Monday, April 13, 2026 at 6:00 pm pursuant to the Missouri Sunshine Law 610.021.

Mayor Ronnie Pearl called the meeting to order with the following members present: Clint Sollars, Darrell Conley, Amy Justus and Larry Zieber.

Also present were City Clerk Pat Fisher-Johnson, Stephanie Ayres, John Miller, Casey Flinn, City Attorney TH Bosler, Robert Walser and Peggy Harwood.

The meeting was called to order and Mayor Pearl led us in the pledge followed by a prayer from Alderman Zieber.

Alderman Sollars made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Seconded by Alderman Justus. Motion carried. This included minutes of the March 17, 2026 meeting and the following checks: Water 7154-7174, Wastewater 3664-3679, Street 4620-4633, General 22261-22283, Pk 1272-1274, SW 1584 and Payroll 11322-11345.

John gave his report on items they have completed since the last meeting: They have been working on meters, fixing meters, replace a sign that had fallen, picked up chemicals for water plant, patched an area around the square, put rock on dam areas, jettered some sewers, measured roads for gravel, fixed lock at water plant, sprayed lift stations for weeds and fixed the manhole on Grant Street.

There was discussion about when we were going to open the bathrooms at Bartlett Park. City Clerk will call and get them scheduled for cleaning, then to continue cleaning them at least twice a week. The restrooms will be open next week.

Stephanie reported that the plant is running as it should. Cameron should start pulling water this week and if all goes well Maysville will start pulling water from the new line on the week of April 20th. Paul Rinehart, General Manager of Alliance who is the managing the GNWWW asked that we not decommission our entire plant for a little bit to make sure we are going to have pressure and our CL2 is

good. TH reminded the board we have 120 days to give DNR the plans for the decommission of the plant. There was discussion about the water in the mixing basins, but they can be drained and torn down in the future.

The board reviewed the rock bid and the streets that John felt needed rocked. After much discussion, the board tabled this to the next meeting so the board members can drive the roads. There was also discussion about attending a township meeting to discuss the use of the grader operator.

At this time Mayor Pearl had a few messages for the board members and wished incoming Mayor Peggy Harwood good luck.

City Clerk then swore in the new elected board members: Clint Sollars, Larry Zieber and Peggy Harwood.

Mayor Harwood asked Larry Zieber if he would be the Mayor Protem. Larry accepted. Motion was made by Alderman Sollars to approve Alderman Zieber, seconded by Alderman Conley. Motion carried.

TH is going to do some research on the position of the Code Enforcer to see who can do this and report back.

Alderman Justus made a motion to go into closed session. Seconded by Alderman Sollars to discuss legal issues. Roll call vote: Conley -yes, Zieber – yes, Sollars – yes and Justus – yes. Motion carried.

Alderman Justus made a motion to go into open session. Seconded by Alderman Conley. Roll call vote: Justus – yes, Sollars – yes, Zieber – yes and Conley – yes. Motion carried.

There was discussion about our current software program. Board members asked City Clerk to ask other clerks what they use and report back.

City Clerk presented the audit for board to review from end of fiscal year 2025.

City Clerk asked board members if they would like to attend the City Officials training in Chillicothe on May 8th. The following will attend: Mayor Harwood, Alderman Zieber, Alderman Conley and City Clerk Pat Fisher.

City Clerk presented the list of goals from a couple to years ago for board members to review and a plan for the upcoming budget meeting.

Next scheduled meeting will be April 27, 2026.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:37 PM.
