

Council Meeting  
December 8, 2025

The Maysville Board of Aldermen met in regular session on Monday, December 8, 2025 at 6:00 pm pursuant to the Missouri Sunshine Law 610.021.

Mayor Ronnie Pearl called the meeting to order with the following members present: Clint Sollars, Darrell Conley, Amy Justus and Larry Zieber.

Also present were City Clerk Pat Fisher-Johnson.

The meeting was called to order and Mayor Pearl led us in the pledge followed by a prayer from Alderman Conley.

Alderman Zieber made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Seconded by Alderman Justus. Motion carried. This included minutes of the November 24, 2025 meeting and the following checks: Water 7074-7082, Wastewater 3606-3614, Street 4565-4573, General 22164-22174, Pk 1259-1261, SW 1580 and Payroll 11176-11184.

The board reviewed a request for gravel on Kennedy Drive.

Alderman Sollars reported the guys have fixed the 2<sup>nd</sup> salter, put on holiday lights, greased all equipment and weather treated all equipment, graveled some roads, put rip rap on Willow Brook dam, worked on lift station on Elm Street, worked on sewer issue on West Main Street and did our first snow removal of the year.

Alderman Sollars asked the board to reconsider the heater for street barn. The wood stove works ok but someone has to be there to stock it on the weekend and with our guys living out of town it isn't getting done. The jetter is stored in the shed and if it gets too cold in the shed it can harm the functions of it. The cost of a mini split is about \$1200. Alderman Zieber made a motion to go ahead to make this purchase. Seconded by Alderman Justus. Motion carried.

City Clerk reported the audit may not be completed by end of year so therefore, there could be additional expenses and a different report will need to be sent to the auditor's office to reflect this.

The letter for the M&G Painting building has been returned unsigned; therefore, City Clerk will contact the attorney to get our next steps and hope to go out for bids to tear the building down very soon.

Alderman Sollars discussed some of his concerns about the City's sewer system and the water system. City Clerk will call DNR about what happens once our plant is taken out of commission – what will be required in testing.

The Board will put the conservation grant on hold until April.

The Board will not have another meeting for the month of December unless issues come up that need to be addressed and a meeting will be called. Next scheduled meeting will be January 12, 2026.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:20 pm.
