

Council Meeting
January 12, 2026

The Maysville Board of Aldermen met in regular session on Monday, January 12, 2026 at 6:00 pm pursuant to the Missouri Sunshine Law 610.021.

Mayor Ronnie Pearl called the meeting to order with the following members present: Clint Sollars, Darrell Conley, Amy Justus and Larry Zieber.

Also present were City Clerk Pat Fisher-Johnson, Stephanie Ayres, Steve Harmon, TH Bosler, Pat McGuire.

The meeting was called to order and Mayor Pearl led us in the pledge followed by a prayer from Alderman Zieber.

Alderman Justus made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Seconded by Alderman Conley. Motion carried. This included minutes of the December 8, 2025 meeting and the following checks: Water 7083-7111, Wastewater 3615-3629, Street 4574-4590, General 22175-22203, Pk 1262-1266, SW 1581, Covid 1516 and Payroll 11185-11234.

Pat McGuire was here to address the board about a possible leak at the gym. After discussion, the board agreed to put a new meter in and see what happens within the next 30 days and then the board will address this issue again.

Stephanie gave a report to the Board members for the waterplant. There was discussion about the connection point for bulk water which will need to be addressed with DNR so we can continue to have bulk water fill. Stephanie gave the Clerk an application for a grant to be filled out for GPS mapping. Clerks will begin on that grant application due in January 31, 2026. There is concern about the Chlorine levels in the new connections so this will be addressed with the engineers.

Alderman Sollars reported the guys have almost completed all of the task that have been lingering. He gave the board a report of the completed items.

City Clerk reported we have a customer that is on DeKalb 1 Water District for the water bill but uses our sewer and a payment hasn't been made for several months. Clerk has called and left owner messages with no return, therefore, we might have to start process to cap off the sewer to the property. Clerk will continue to make the effort to collect funds before we do this.

Alderman Justus made a motion to go into closed session to discuss legal issues. Seconded by Alderman Sollars. Roll call vote: Justus – yes, Sollars – yes, Zieber – yes, and Conley – yes. Motion carried.

Alderman Justus made a motion to go back into open session. Seconded by Alderman Conley. Roll call vote: Conley – yes, Zieber – yes, Sollars – yes and Justus – yes. Motion carried.

Alderman Sollars made a motion to approve the financial statement for the past 6 months. Seconded by Alderman Conley. Motion carried.

Alderman Sollars made a motion to enter into an agreement with MU Extension for workshops sponsored by the MAIN group. Seconded by Alderman Conley. Motion carried.

Both clerks will be attending the Spring Institute in Columbia in March so Sarah can start earning her degree in City government. Pat will continue to build hours for her certifications – she has the highest degree for the clerks she can receive.

Alderman Justus made a motion to put ordinance 2026-01 on its first reading by title only, "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MAYSVILLE, MO TO ESTABLISH A PROCEEDURE TO DISCLOSE POTENTIAL CONFLICT OF INTEREST AND SUBSTANTIAL INTEREST FOR CERTAIN OFFICIALS". Seconded by Alderman Sollars. Roll call vote: Justus – yes, Conley – yes, Zieber – yes and Sollars – yes. Motion carried.


Alderman Sollars made motion to put ordinance #2026-01 on it's second and final reading by title only "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MAYSVILLE, MO TO ESTABLISH A PROCEDURE TO DISCLOSE POTENTIAL CONFLICT OF INTEREST AND SUBSTANTIAL INTERESTS FOR CERTAIN OFFICIALS". Seconded by Alderman Zieber. Roll call vote: Alderman Zieber – yes, Conley – yes, Justus – yes and Sollars – yes. Motion carried.

The Board did have discussion about posting on public social media pages.

Next scheduled meeting will be January 26, 2026.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:13 pm.
