

Council Meeting
March 17, 2026

The Maysville Board of Aldermen met in regular session on Tuesday, March 17, 2026 at 5:30 pm pursuant to the Missouri Sunshine Law 610.021.

Mayor Ronnie Pearl called the meeting to order with the following members present: Clint Sollars, Darrell Conley, Amy Justus and Larry Zieber.

Also present were City Clerk Pat Fisher-Johnson, Stephanie Ayres, John Miller, Casey Flinn, TH Bosler, Steve Harman, Bill Fisher, Dustin Miller and Peggy Harwood.

The meeting was called to order and Mayor Pearl led us in the pledge followed by a prayer from Alderman Zieber.

Alderman Zieber made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Seconded by Alderman Sollars. Motion carried. This included minutes of the February 23, 2026 meeting and the following checks: Water 7143-7153, Wastewater 3655-3663, Street 4612-4619, General 22242-22260, Pk 1271, SW 1583 and Payroll 11296-11321.

Alderman Sollars made a motion to go into closed session. Seconded by Alderman Justus. Roll call vote: Conley -yes, Zieber – yes, Sollars – yes and Justus – yes. Motion carried.

Alderman Justus made a motion to open into open session. Seconded by Alderman Sollars. Roll call vote: Justus – yes, Sollars – yes, Zieber – yes and Conley – yes. Motion carried.

Alderman Sollars made a motion to hire Dustin Miller beginning March 23, 2026 at \$19 per hour for the laborer position. Seconded by Alderman Justus. Motion carried. Dustin's hours will be 8 to 4:30pm for a 40-hour week unless emergencies.

Alderman Sollars gave John's report on what he has completed in the past couple of week: Maintenance the vehicles, cleaned the fence line at the frog pond,

cleaned truck, did lift station readings and treated them, worked on some streets, cleaned the shop, got the salter cleaned up for next year, replaced some meters, finished the landscape timbers at the Archery range, replace the door at the new water plant tower, and worked on the dam at ballfield reservoir.



The board agreed to hire one more summer helper and see if the other boys are wanting to come back.


Next scheduled meeting will be April 13, 2026.
