

Maysville Board of Aldermen  
April 8, 2024

The Maysville Board of Aldermen met in regular session on Monday, April 8, 2024 at 6:00 p.m. in open session pursuant to the Missouri Sunshine Law 610.021.

The Mayor Robert Walser called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm with the following board members present: Peggy Harwood, Clint Sollars, and Amy Justus. Tyler Zimmerman was unable to attend.

Also present were: Michele Allwood, Jennifer Justus, Larry Zieber, Ron Pearl, Matt Brodersen, MIRMA and Pat Fisher Johnson.

Mayor Walser opened the meeting with the pledge.

Alderman Justus made a motion to approve the consent agenda, minutes of the March 25, 2024 minutes and the following checks: Water ck # 6568-6577, Wastewater ck# 3319-3325, Street ck# 4255-4259, General ck#21687-21698, Park ck#1209, SW ck#1609, and Payroll ck#103026-10341. Seconded by Alderman Sollars. Motion carried.

Matt was present to propose his MIRMA insurance plan. MIRMA is a risk pool insurance which currently has 97 cities. Our coverage would be prorated as they start their policies all on July 1. Discussion was held on regarding how their policies work and how the City would pay.

After much discussion, Alderman Sollars made a motion to continue our coverage with JB-LB Insurance who did his presentation at the last meeting. Seconded by Alderman Justus. Motion carried.

The Board did discuss having a monthly safety meeting and documenting of each meeting.

Jennifer reported that MO Dot still hasn't posted the signs for no parking on the corner of HWY 6 and Washington Street so she will make contact with them again. Once the signs are placed then we can paint the curbing red and possibly put cones there so people are aware that it is a no parking area.

Jennifer reported the recent ordinances that were passed are now on the web page.

Michele reported the hydrants are scheduled to be flushed on April 9 & 10<sup>th</sup>.

Michele thanked the board and Pat for attending her award ceremony when she received the Bill Hills Award during her conference in St Joseph.

Michele stated Steve McDowell was assisting with the lagoon test that is required by DNR.

Michele reported that Brandon from Missouri Rural Water will be here from June 4 – 7<sup>th</sup> to get our GIS completed.

The board agreed to add to the laborer's job description, that employees are required to get a DS II license and a D wastewater license. Michele's job title will be Deputy Clerk /Water-Wastewater Supervisor.

Alderman Justus made a motion to accept the April 2nd election results with Ronnie Pearl, Mayor, Clint Sollars and Larry Zieber both getting the Alderman positions. Seconded by Alderman Harwood. Motion carried.

City Clerk then swore in Ronnie Pearl, Mayor, Clint Sollars Eastward Alderman and Larry Zieber Westward Alderman for their two-year term.

Alderman Justus made a motion to elect Peggy Harwood as Mayor Pro-tem. Seconded by Alderman Sollars. Motion carried.

The board discussed their future goals for the City of Maysville, upcoming meetings and who would be able to attend them.

Mayor Pearl and Alderman Zieber will be going to the Newly Elected Officials Conference in June in Columbia.

Board agreed to apply for a Region D Recycling Grant for more picnic tables for Bartlett Park and possibly a sign. Applications are due on May 9<sup>th</sup>.

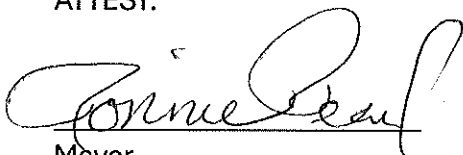

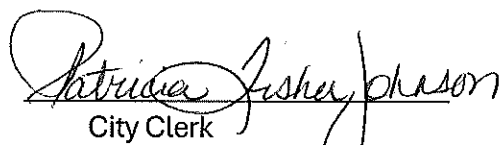
With no further business the meeting was adjourned at 9:30 pm.
