

Maysville Board of Aldermen
July 22, 2024

The Maysville Board of Aldermen met in regular session on Monday, July 22, 2024 at 6:00 p.m. in open session pursuant to the Missouri Sunshine Law 610.021.

Mayor Ronnie Pearl called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm with the following board members present: Peggy Harwood, Larry Zieber, Clint Sollars and Amy Justus.

Also present were: Michele Allwood, Alex Pfouts and Pat Fisher Johnson.

Mayor Pearl opened the meeting with the pledge and Alderman Harwood said the prayer.

Alderman Sollars made a motion to approve the consent agenda, minutes of the July 8, 2024 minutes and the following checks: Water ck# 6656-6663, Wastewater ck# 3365-3370, Street ck# 4298-4302, General ck# 21782-21791, and Payroll ck# 10460-10482. Seconded by Alderman Harwood. Motion carried.

Michele reported that she was having a DNR inspection next Tuesday so she is getting information together for that. She has been changing chemicals to help water issues and flushing hydrants.

Michele reported that she has talked with the engineers about the connection to the plant and will have to get some questions answered and follow back up. Once this is done, we should be ready to go out to bid to get the installation for the new water line to come into the clearwell.

The board discussed the storm drains and the water that gets into the storm drains – why Highway 6 doesn't have any like Highway 33.

City Clerk reported she has visited with the city crew about preparing for Country Harvest. Country Harvest is August 8, 9 and 10th.

Alderman Sollars asked what color did we want the metal on the new street shed. The board agreed on red and black. The shed will be facing the south, with no doors. The city crew is in the process of removing the old shed. That metal will be used to replace the roof on the former bathroom.

Alderman Sollars and Alderman Justus met with Barb Denny, Mo Dept of Conservation, to work on grants to help with items at the reservoir. They are developing a plan for 50/50 funding and our 50% could also be in-kind work.

Alderman Sollars reported he is waiting for an estimate on grader repairs or trade in value. There was discussion about other city equipment and making trade ins on it.

Alderman Justus made a motion to spend up to \$1000 on gas tanks for the back of the truck. Seconded by Alderman Sollars. Motion carried.

The board reviewed the bid for AC units to be replaced at city hall. More bids will need to be accepted due to the cost of replacement.

Alderman Sollars is working on getting the police car repaired so the city can decide what they are going to do with it.

City Clerk stated our public hearing will be at our next meeting for the 2024 tax levy.

There was discussion about a farmers market sign/banner – clerk will get some bids.

City Clerk was given permission to get our credit limit increased on the credit cards.



Seconded by Alderman Justus. Roll call vote: Harwood – yes, Sollars – yes, Justus – yes and Zieber – yes. Motion carried.

Alderman Justus made a motion to put Ordinance #2024-09 on its second and final reading by title only, "CITY OF MAYSVILLE SHALL ALLOWING SHIPPING CONTAINERS TO BE USED AS ACCESSORY BUILDINGS." Seconded by Alderman Zieber. Roll call vote: Harwood – yes, Sollars – yes, Justus – yes and Zieber – yes. Motion carried.


With no further business the meeting was adjourned at 8:57 pm.
