

Council Meeting
September 17, 2025

The Maysville Board of Aldermen met in regular session on Wednesday, September 17, 2025 at 6:00 pm pursuant to the Missouri Sunshine Law 610.021.

Mayor Ronnie Pearl called the meeting to order with the following members present: Clint Sollars, Darrell Conley, and Larry Zieber. Alderman Amy Justus was unable to attend.

Also present were City Clerk Pat Fisher-Johnson, Stephanie Ayres, Casey Flinn, Mark Murphy, Tyler Thomas and Richard Meek.

The meeting was called to order and Mayor Pearl led us in the pledge followed by a prayer from Alderman Zieber.

Alderman Zieber made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Seconded by Alderman Conley. Motion carried. This included minutes of the August 25, 2025 and September 16, 2025 meetings and the following checks: Water 7011-7034, Wastewater 3562-3575, Street 4502-4518, General 22088-22107, Pk 1243-1245, and Payroll 11054-11095.

Mark, Tyler and Richard were here to discuss some issue with brush, washouts and grader agreements. The board agreed to help with the gravel to fill a sink hole south of the bridge by Willow Brook. The township also removed some brush along the side of the road but there is more that needs to be removed. The township also reminded the city that the Offutt tube has not been cleaned out yet and the gravel needs to go back onto the road. The township and City agreed to use the township's grader and driver and we will pay his hourly fee.

Stephanie and Casey were here to give a water update. The plant is running smoothly. The basins were both cleaned in August and will begin flushing hydrants this week. There was discussion about the bill for the water line break at Lakesite. Casey reported they are waiting for Micro Comm to get closer to the connection point to start the connection work. Casey said it should take two weeks to make our connection.

There was discussion about Maysville Country Harvest. There are several people who are willing to come on to the Committee to help, with new ideas and plans for next year.

Alderman Sollars reported the crew has have been busy with water breaks, mowing, and getting ready for Country Harvest.

The board agreed to allow Jeff Rager, salesman, to use our Neptune Jetter for a show, in return, his company will do a full service on it. Jeff will come and get the jetter on the week of October 6th.

The board agreed to reimburse Ronnie Stahl and Fred Kiehl on their sidewalk projects.

Alderman Sollars made a motion to put ordinance 2025-20 on its first read by title only, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MAYSVILLE ESTABLISHING THE WATER RATE INCREASE EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 2025. Seconded by Alderman Zieber. Roll call vote: Sollars – yes, Conely – yes and Zieber – yes. Motion carried.

Alderman Zieber made a motion to put ordinance 2025-20 on its second and final reading by title only” AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MAYSVILLE ESTABLISHING THE WATER RATE INCREASE EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 2025. Seconded by Alderman Sollars. Roll call vote: Sollars – yes, Conley – yes and Zieber – yes. Motion carried.

Alderman Conley made a motion to put ordinance 2025-21 on its first reading by title only, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MAYSVILLE ESTABLISHING THE SEWER RATE INCREASE EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 2025. Seconded by Alderman Sollars. Roll call vote: Sollars – yes, Conely – yes and Zieber – yes. Motion carried.

Alderman Sollars made a motion to put ordinance 2025-21 on its second and final reading by title only, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MAYSVILLE ESTABLISHING THE SEWER RATE INCREASE EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 2025. Seconded by Alderman Conley. Roll call vote: Sollars – yes, Conely – yes and Zieber – yes. Motion carried.

Alderman Sollars reported he met with the forestry people to do a grant for us at the lakes. The city can do in-kind for their match money and we could get up to \$9800. Board agreed to proceed.

The Board passed Resolution 2025-15 to proceed with the park grant that Kathy Kagay has been writing for us to get money for playground equipment for Bartlett Park.

There was discussion about hunting on City property. The board agreed for Archery hunting only.

With no further business, Alderman Zieber made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Alderman Conley. Motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:50 pm and the next meeting will be October 14th at 6:00 pm.
